Mission: Climate-Neutral and Smart Cities' with **five IPA cities (Berane - ME, Durres - AL, Pancevo - RS, Sarajevo - BA and Skopje - MK)**, with the aim to establish a mentorship network that supports tailored strategies for the transition to climate-neutral transportation systems.

Primary goal of TERRAIN is to help cities align with the EU's ambitious climate neutrality targets by reducing emissions, improving transportation efficiency, and fostering urban green spaces.
